THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

Have you ever broken any of the 10 Commandments, even in thought? If you have ever broken one, then you are guilty of all, and are a sinner deserving of death! "When people sin, they earn what sin pays—death..." (Romans 6:23a).

Deaf people are just as capable of sinning as hearing people. "All people have sinned and are not good enough for God's glory" (Romans 3:23). But God desires that all people (deaf included) come to repentance and surrender to Him, "...But God gives His people a free gift—life forever in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 6:23b). How do we do this? We first agree with God that we have sinned and broken His commands. Then we promise to turn away from our sin. Next we believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, who died to pay the penalty for our sins and rose from the dead on the third day. Finally, we place our trust Him as our Savior.
